### **Requirements:**

- Student, at least 16 years of age as of May 1, 2010 – returning full time to a recognized secondary school, college or university program in September
- Resident of Lakeshore
- Valid Drivers License (Class G2) with clean driving abstract
- Good physical condition and ability to work outdoors in all weather conditions
- Protective footwear (steel toed boots)
- Ability to communicate effectively with the public
- Ability to follow direction and take initiative and exercise judgement to ensure the effective completion of assigned tasks
- Ability to work in a team environment or independently, as may be required to assist the environmental services staff in carrying out assigned tasks including painting, minor maintenance and odd job duties

### **Duties:**

- Hydrant painting and minor maintenance repairs to fire hydrants located throughout the municipality
- May include shop maintenance and clean up
- Any other related duties and tasks that may be assigned from time to time by the lead hand/working foreman in water distribution.
