PARKS AND SPORT FIELDS MAINTENANCE OPERATOR

Reporting to the Manager of Recreation and Facilities under the general direction and guidance of the full time Parks and Sports Field Maintenance Operator this position will perform a variety of duties related to the maintenance and upkeep of all municipal parks and open spaces including the maintenance of sports turf, tree and plant inventories, with a focus on quality customer service and continuous improvement processes.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Minimum Grade 12
- College degree in Turf Management and/or Horticulture or Agricultural field would be considered an asset
- Mechanical aptitude with field experience and ability to operate relevant mechanical equipment including small tools, chainsaws, garden tractor, lawn equipment etc.
- Valid Class G drivers license with clean driving abstract

DUTIES:

May include but are not limited to the following:

- Maintenance of municipal parks and equipment
- Maintenance of outdoor sports fields and associated facilities including players' benches, backstops, fence lines and bleacher areas in co-operation with scheduled users and tournaments
- Maintenance of Parks tree and plant inventory
- Performance of weekly, monthly and annual playground inspections and maintenance of all documentation related to these inspections
- Completion of all required repairs resulting from inspections in a timely and effective manner
- Performance of other related duties as may be necessary and assigned from time to time by the Manager of Recreation and Facilities or his designate

WORKING CONDITIONS AND HOURS OF WORK:

- Good physical condition and able to perform the physical demands of the job
- May be required to work in inclement weather conditions
- 40 hours per week with evening and weekend hours as may be required between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. Monday to Sunday

- Work schedules will be posted at least two weeks in advance
