

# THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF LAKESHORE

## BY-LAW NO. 58-2019

### A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 97-2004, BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF WATER SUPPLY IN THE TOWN OF LAKESHORE

**WHEREAS** By-Law Number 97-2004, a by-law to provide for the regulation of water supply in the Town of Lakeshore was duly passed by the Council on the 19 day of July, 2004.

**AND WHEREAS** Council deems it necessary to amend Section 3.5, 3.6 and 3.7 of By-law 97-2004 to provide a policy that will describe the procedure for water charges that remain unpaid after 45 days;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Lakeshore enacts as follows:

1. That Section 3.5, 3.6 and 3.7 of by-law 97-2004 is hereby deleted and replaced with the following:

"3.5 When account remains unpaid the current bill is issued together with the previous bill charges and as shown in the tariff of fees by-law, interest shall be applied to outstanding charges.


3.6 If the customer at any premise omits, neglects or refuses to pay any bill rendered, whether for water service pipes, meter, service charge or any other monies to which the Town may be entitled in respect of water services to such premises, the Town shall, after two (2) consecutive billing cycles, transfer water arrears including original charges and interest to the property's tax account. Such charges shall remain a lien on the property where they have been incurred and may be collected in the same manner as taxes.

3.7 Where it has been necessary to transfer arrears to the property tax account as a result of non-payment, an administration fee as shown in the tariff of fees by-law, will be levied against the delinquent account."

#### Effective Date

2. This By-law shall come into full force and effect upon passage.
