



## ***TOWN OF LAKESHORE STORMWATER MASTER PLAN – PHASE 1*** **NOTICE OF COMPLETION**

The Town of Lakeshore has carried out a Stormwater Master Plan to identify necessary storm drainage system improvements to reduce flooding caused by severe rainfall events. The proposed servicing plan will identify both private and public drainage system improvements required to mitigate the possibility of basement flooding during extreme storms. The nature of the recommended undertakings are such that the project is identified as and being conducted as a Master Plan project following Approach 2 under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process for Municipal Stormwater Projects (Municipal Engineers Association, October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011 and 2015). The Environment Study Report has been completed and by this Notice is being placed in the public record for review. This Environmental Study Report documents the planning and decision-making process starting with identification of the problem through to selection of the preferred solutions.

Interested persons should provide written comments to the Town of Lakeshore at the address above by August 21, 2020. If concerns regarding any of the proposed individual projects cannot be resolved in discussion with the Town of Lakeshore, a person may request that the Minister of the Environment make an order for the project to comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act (referred to as a Part II Order), which addresses individual environmental assessments. Requests must be received by the Minister at the address below by August 28, 2020. A copy of the request must also be sent to the Town of Lakeshore at the address above. All projects not subject to a Part II Order will proceed to design and construction, pending the necessary approvals and allocation of appropriate funding, as outlined in the Environment Study Report.
