Subject: Decision not to veto June 23, 2026 by-laws

In accordance with section 284.11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* (the “Act”), and Ontario Regulation 530/22, despite any procedure by-law, if the head of council is of the opinion that all or part of a by-law could potentially interfere with a prescribed provincial authority, the head of council may provide written notice to the council of the intent to consider vetoing the by-law.

Section 284.11(4)(a)(i) allows the head of council to provide written approval of the by-law (decision not to veto the by-law).

I, Tracey Bailey, Mayor of the Municipality of Lakeshore, hereby approve the following by-law adopted by Council at the June 23, 2026 meeting:

1. By-law 35-2026, Being a By-law to deem certain lots to no longer be registered lots on a plan of subdivision (Deem-08-2026);
2. By-law 36-2026, Being a By-law to authorize the execution of a Subdivision Agreement pertaining to Cooper Mills Phase 2 Subdivision;
3. By-Law 37-2026, Being a By-law to authorize the execution of a Subdivision Agreement pertaining to Forest Hills 5A;
4. By-law 39-2026, Being a By-law to delegate authority for Community Improvement Plan Financial Incentive Applications and Related Agreements; and
5. By-law 41-2026, Being a By-law to Confirm the Proceedings of the June 9, 2026 Council Meeting.
