Subject: Decision not to veto March 10, 2026 by-laws

In accordance with section 284.11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* (the “Act”), and Ontario Regulation 530/22, despite any procedure by-law, if the head of council is of the opinion that all or part of a by-law could potentially interfere with a prescribed provincial authority, the head of council may provide written notice to the council of the intent to consider vetoing the by-law.

Section 284.11(4)(a)(i) allows the head of council to provide written approval of the by-law (decision not to veto the by-law).

I, Tracey Bailey, Mayor of the Municipality of Lakeshore, hereby approve the following by-laws adopted by Council at the March 10, 2026 meeting:

1. By-law 17-2026, Being a By-law to Authorize an Agreement with His Majesty the King in right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Infrastructure (Housing-Enabling Water Systems Fund)
2. By-law 18-2026, Being a By-law to Authorize an Agreement with His Majesty the King in right of Canada as represented by the Minister of Housing and Infrastructure and Minister responsible for Pacific Economic Development Canada
3. By-law 19-2026, Being a By-law to Confirm the Proceedings of the February 24, 2026 Council Meeting
