**Subject:** Decision not to veto April 14, 2026 by-laws

---

In accordance with section 284.11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* (the “Act”), and Ontario Regulation 530/22, despite any procedure by-law, if the head of council is of the opinion that all or part of a by-law could potentially interfere with a prescribed provincial authority, the head of council may provide written notice to the council of the intent to consider vetoing the by-law.

Section 284.11(4)(a)(i) allows the head of council to provide written approval of the by-law (decision not to veto the by-law).

I, Tracey Bailey, Mayor of the Municipality of Lakeshore, hereby approve the following by-laws adopted by Council at the April 14, 2026 meeting:

1. By-law 101-2021, Being a By-law for the Chauvin Blanchette Drain and Kennedy Drain in the Municipality of Lakeshore.
2. By-law 23-2026, Being a By-law to Amend By-law 4-2006 (Parking By-law).
3. By-law 24-2026, Being a By-law to Confirm the Proceedings of the March 24, 2026 Council Meeting.
