**Date:** December 9, 2025

**Subject:** Decision not to veto December 9, 2025 by-laws

---

In accordance with section 284.11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* (the “Act”), and Ontario Regulation 530/22, despite any procedure by-law, if the head of council is of the opinion that all or part of a by-law could potentially interfere with a prescribed provincial authority, the head of council may provide written notice to the council of the intent to consider vetoing the by-law.

Section 284.11(4)(a)(i) allows the head of council to provide written approval of the by-law (decision not to veto the by-law).

I, Tracey Bailey, Mayor of the Municipality of Lakeshore, hereby approve the following by-laws adopted by Council at the December 9, 2025 meeting:

1. By-law 83-2025, Being a By-law to amend By-law 2-2012, Zoning By-law for the Municipality of Lakeshore (ZBA-10-2025)
2. By-law 85-2025, Being a By-law to Repeal the Community Benefit Fund Grants Policy
3. By-law 89-2025, Being a By-law to Confirm the Proceedings of the November 18, 2025 Council Meeting
