**Subject:** Decision not to veto May 6, 2025 by-laws

In accordance with section 284.11 of the *Municipal Act, 2001* (the "Act"), and Ontario Regulation 530/22, despite any procedure by-law, if the head of council is of the opinion that all or part of a by-law could potentially interfere with a prescribed provincial authority, the head of council may provide written notice to the council of the intent to consider vetoing the by-law.

Section 284.11(4)(a)(i) allows the head of council to provide written approval of the by-law (decision not to veto the by-law).

I, Tracey Bailey, Mayor of the Municipality of Lakeshore, hereby approve the following by-laws adopted by Council at the May 6, 2025 meeting:

- 1. By-law 36-2025, Being a By-law to extend the Time Period for Part Lot Control By-law 65-2022 for Blocks 1, 2, and Part of Block 3, Plan 12M-640, in the former Community of Maidstone, now in the Municipality of Lakeshore (PLC-1-2025)
- 2. By-law 38-2025, Being a By-law to Adopt OPA 21 to the Lakeshore Official Plan
